

# Aerangis coriacea



**Native of:** Kenya and Tanzania

**Habitat:** Epiphytic at low level on tree trunks in shade in upland forest often near a river from 1300 to 2300m

**Description:** small plant with 15cm thick leaves arching flower stems carrying up to 22 flowers which are white tinged with pink or green. The flowers have long curving spurs.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow this plant mounted and grow it warm (min15°C) in low light but its range implies it could grow cooler.

**Flowering season:** Summer

**Flask to flowering approx:** 2-3 yrs
