

Aerangis-hyaloides



Native of: Madagascar

Habitat: Epiphyte in evergreen forest in Eastern Madagascar.

Description: a miniature plant with 6cm leaves and small 1cm white flowers borne in dense spikes of up to 25 flowers. Mature plants produce large numbers of flower stems so that the plant is a mass of flowers.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this plant mounted and grow it hot (min 18°C) in low light.

Flowering season: spring

Flask to flowering approx: We have had this species flower in flask.
