

Angraecum protensum



Native of: Madagascar

Habitat: Lithophyte growing on rocks at high altitudes from 2000m.

Description: Medium sized plant that forms a clump & produces large flowers of a very pure white.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species in pots up on a shelf to get good light. Because of its altitude this plant should need intermediate temperatures (min 12°C).

Flowering season: August

Flask to flowering approx. 4yrs.
